

MKCL workshop for Olympiad students

Pune: As part of its Science Olympiad Abhiyan, the Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Limited (MKCL) is training 25 students from across the state, out of which five will represent India at the International Junior Science Olympiad, which will be held in Nigeria in December.

The four-day workshop, which started in the city on Tuesday, will train students who have passed the first level of the National standard examination in junior science (NSEJS). Being conducted by MKCL's nurturing excellence and talent team, it will include a series of lectures by experts and scientists.

The NSEJS is held all over India and top 300 students are selected for the second level exam. The selected students attend a camp, which includes several theoretical and experimental tests after which they are graded on the basis of aggregate score. The workshop will enable students to develop the right approach for the Olympiad.
