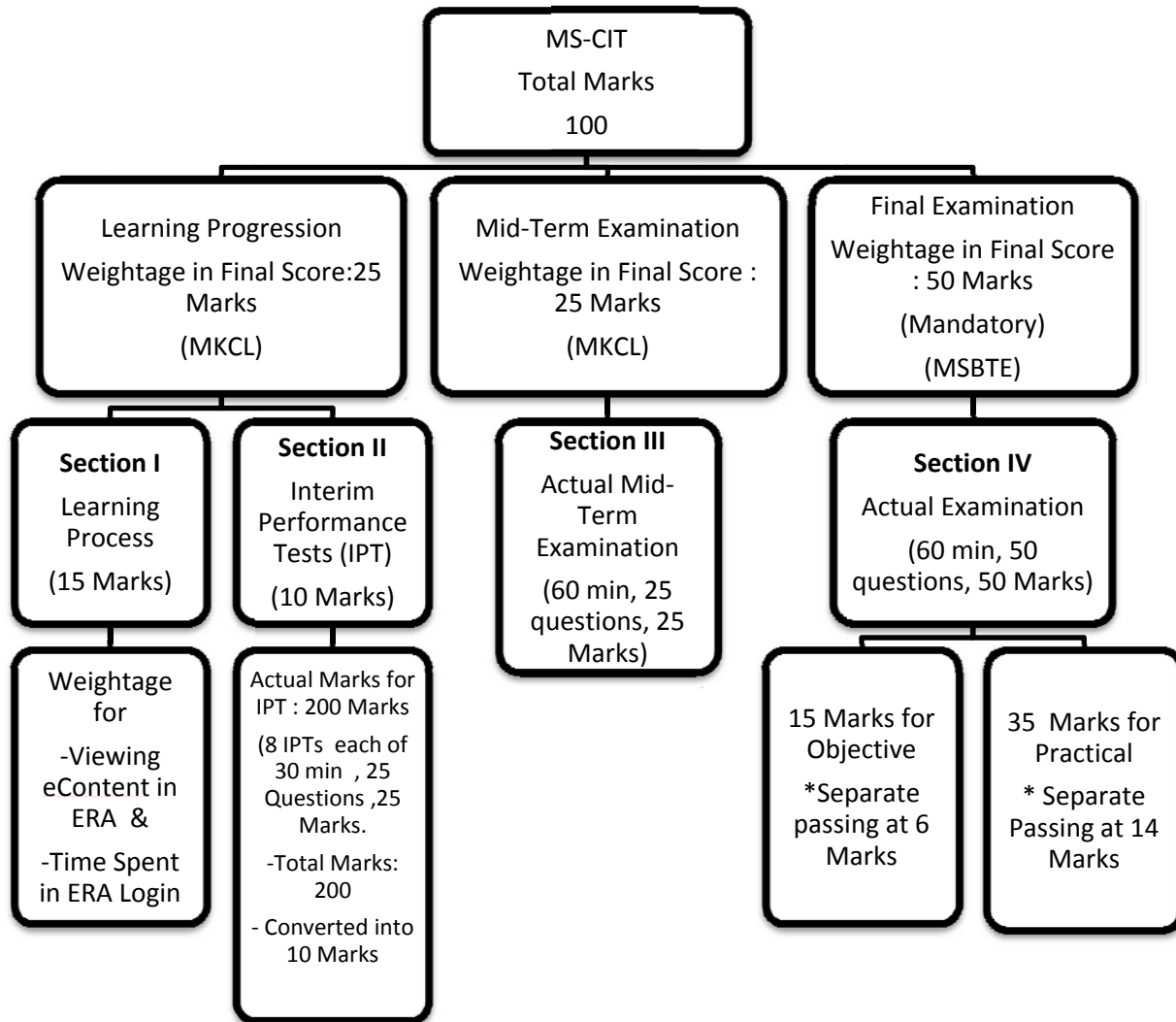

1 Evaluation Structure:

MS-CIT Evaluation will comprise of four sections, as enlisted below:

- Learning Process
- Interim Performance Tests(IPTs)
- Mid-Term Examination
- Final MS-CIT Examination



- **Learning Progression** section will comprise of the marks a learner gains by completing the Learning process in MKCL's ERA Framework, this will comprise of Learning and Interim Performance Tests (IPTs) in ERA.

- **Mid-Term Examination** will be a supervised examination conducted at all the MS-CIT ALC locations on pre specified dates.
- **Final MS-CIT Examination** will be conducted by MSBTE on monthly basis at selected number of Exam Centers at the end of the course. The pattern of the examination will be unchanged. Learner has to pass in Final MS-CIT Examination, irrespective of his score in other three sections, to receive the final MS-CIT Certificate.
- The marks obtained in the above mentioned sections will have following weightage in Final MS-CIT Certificate:

Section	Max. Marks
Learning Progression: Learning Process	15
Learning Progression: Interim Performance Tests (IPTs)	10
Mid-Term Examination	25
Final MS-CIT Examination	50
Total	100

2 Modified Passing Criteria for MS-CIT Course

Following are two criteria for passing the MS-CIT Examination successfully:

- Minimum 20 Marks out of 50 are required for passing final MS-CIT Examination (Section IV) with separate passing in objective and practical.
- Aggregate score in all sections (i.e. I to IV) required for passing is 50 marks out of 100 Marks (Learning progression: 25, Mid-Term Examination 25, Final Examination 50).

Aggregate score in all sections (i.e. I to IV) will be reflected in Final Result of the passed learner.

Passing criteria is same for fresh as well as re-exam learners.
